SEMINAR ON GASB 34

In conjunction with the Government Accounting Standards Board, the NFMA is sponsoring a seminar covering the new GASB Statement 34 financial reporting model standards.

David Bean, Director of Research for GASB, and Dr. Gil Crain, Associate Professor at Montana State University, will provide a full presentation on the implementation of GASB 34. Registrants will receive the GASB Statement 34 User Guide entitled "An Analyst's Guide to Government Financial Statements". This one-day seminar will cover all of the features of the new financial reporting model. Topics to be covered include:
